## 3. Entry requirements

#### 4. Course content

This course is about "dynamic semantics", where the meaning of a sentence is a function that updates the context, rather than a description of the world. Why should we believe in this? In this course we will cover the two most important empirical motivations:

- 1. "Donkey sentences" like "If Pedro owns a donkey then he likes it"
- 2. The projection problem for presuppositions: When the presuppositions of a complex sentence are presuppositions of its parts.

## 5. Learning outcomes

By the end of the course it is expected that students can:

•Explain why it is hard to analyze donkey sentences in static semantic theories

- •Explain how donkey sentences can be analyzed in dynamic theories, including File Change Semantics and Discourse Representation Theory
- •Explain the advantages of dynamic semantics when it comes to the projection problem for presuppositions Practical Skills
  - •Distinguish between different types of semantic content, including presuppositions, entailments, and implicatures
  - •Analyse simple sentences in Discourse Representation Theory

#### Analytical Skills

- •Choose between various theories of definite and indefinite descriptions, pronouns, and presuppositions
- •Criticize analyses and identify research questions
